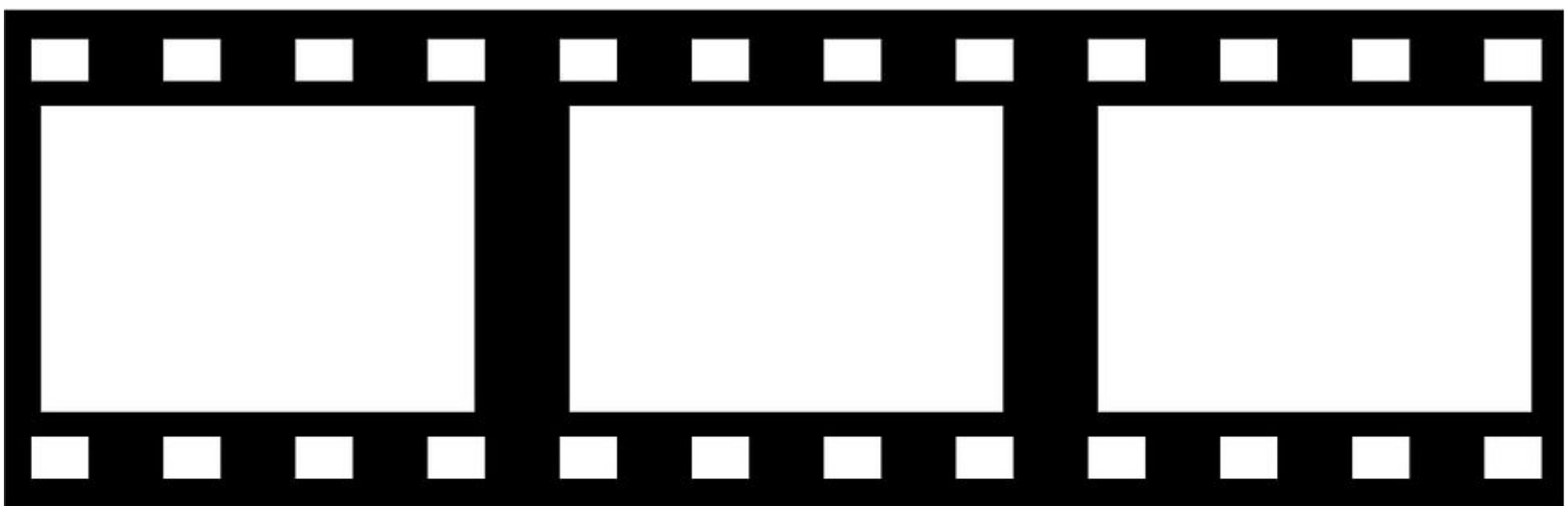


# The Oratory Schools of St. Philip Neri School System Film Festival

#### **How to Enter:**

You must attend a meeting on Thursday, October 4, 2017 to go over rules and guidelines. All work needs to utilize original ideas, images, and music. Entries must be submitted before October 15, 2017, so the film can be deemed eligible for the festival. Please remember it needs to be appropriate for a Catholic audience. Finalists will be selected for the film festival that will be held in the lecture hall during the Fall Festival.

#### **Entry Fee**

In order for your film to be considered as a finalist, you will need to pay \$20 for each film and the group needs to complete an entry form. A Google Classroom will be created and it is important to make arrangements to get the code and information at the meeting to complete the entry form and develop an MP4 file. **If the film is over 5 minutes, it can not be used. No refunds for films not considered as a finalist. There will be a panel of three judge to decide the 6 finalists.**

#### **Cover Charge on the Day of the Event**

Student Council and NHS will be organizing and sponsoring the 30 minute event and there will be a \$5 dollar cover charge to view the final films of the six finalists. At the end of the event, the judges will declare the winners. All proceeds for this event will go towards the Fall Festival.
